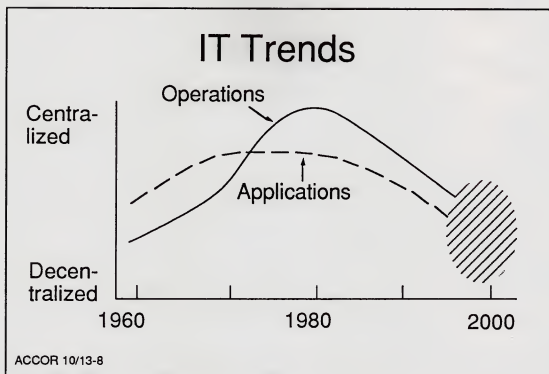

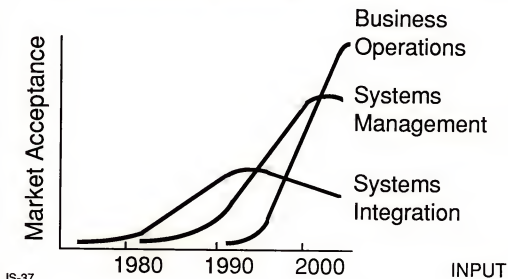
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Outsourcing Market Waves



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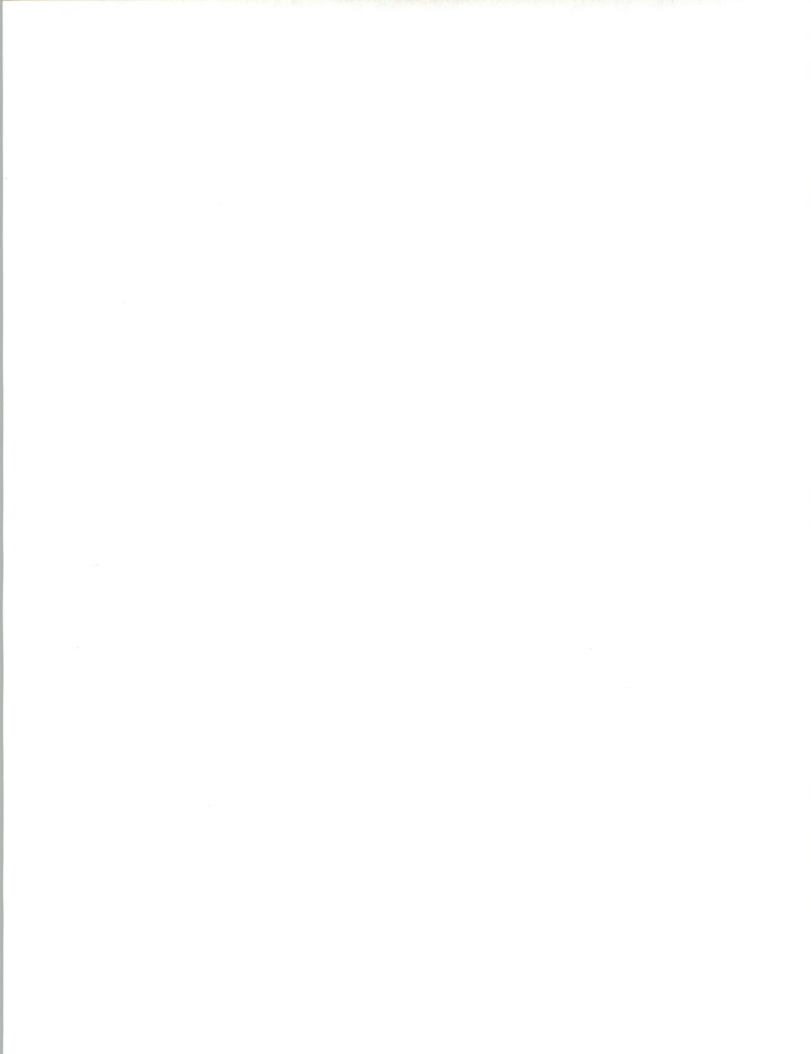

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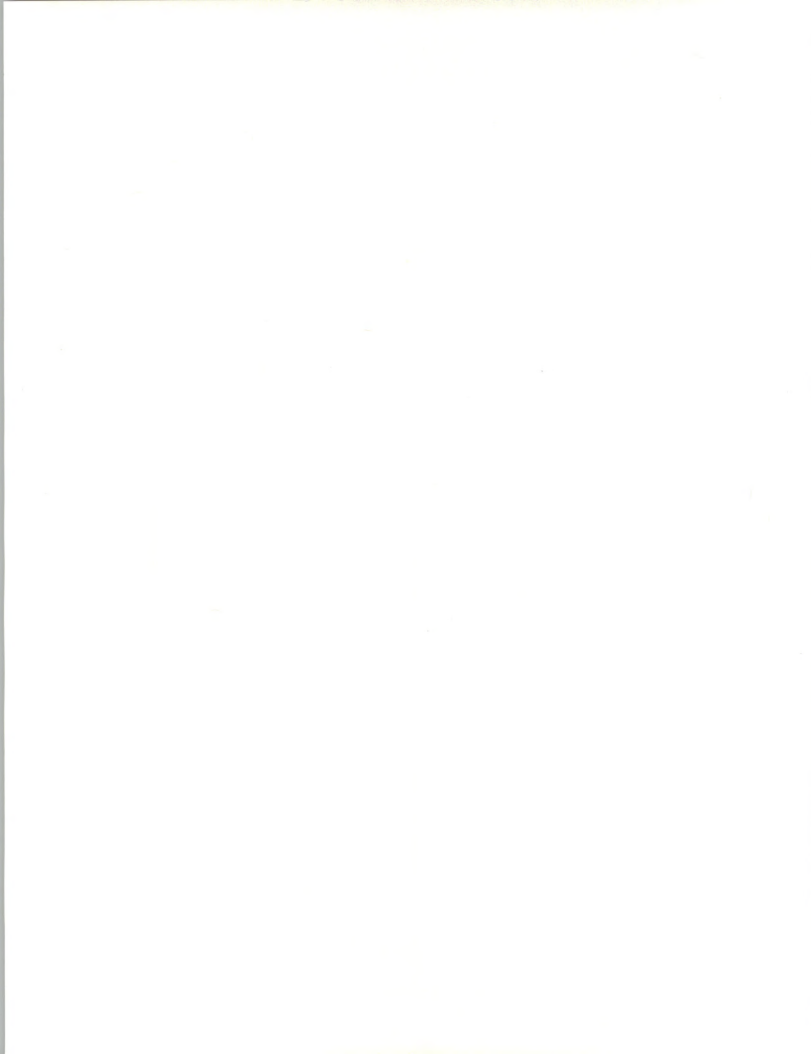
Transition Management

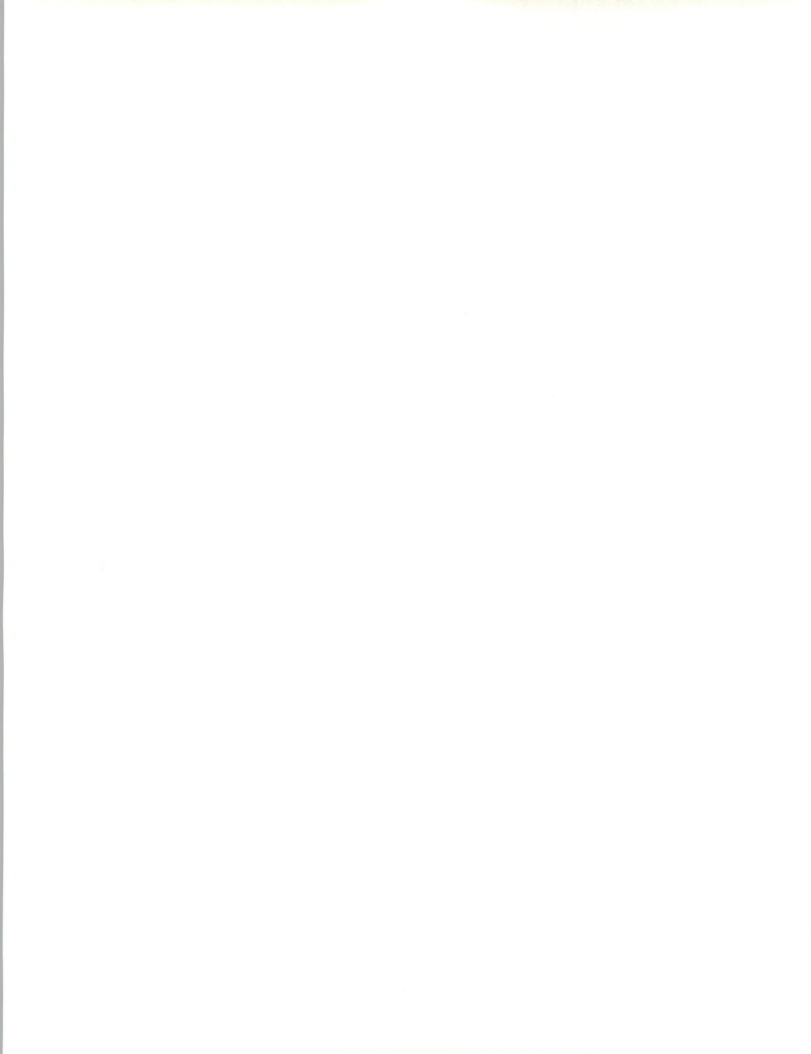
Xerox

Outsourcing Contract

CSC—General Dynamics

- \$3 billion over ten years
- 2,600 people transfer to CSC
- Applications management/processing
- Culture=2 defense contractors

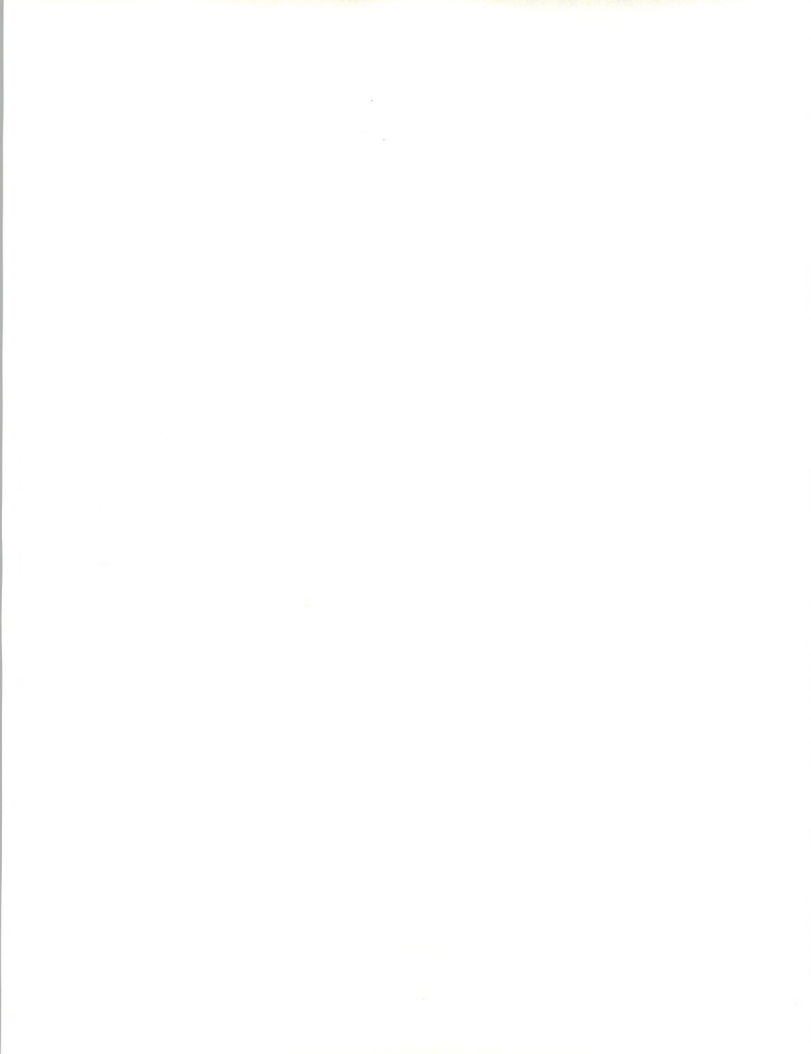
Equifax

- Network management, data center management

- Improve customer support

- \$2b over ten years
- Transfer of 13 data centers in April 1994
- Eventual transfer of 2000 civil servants

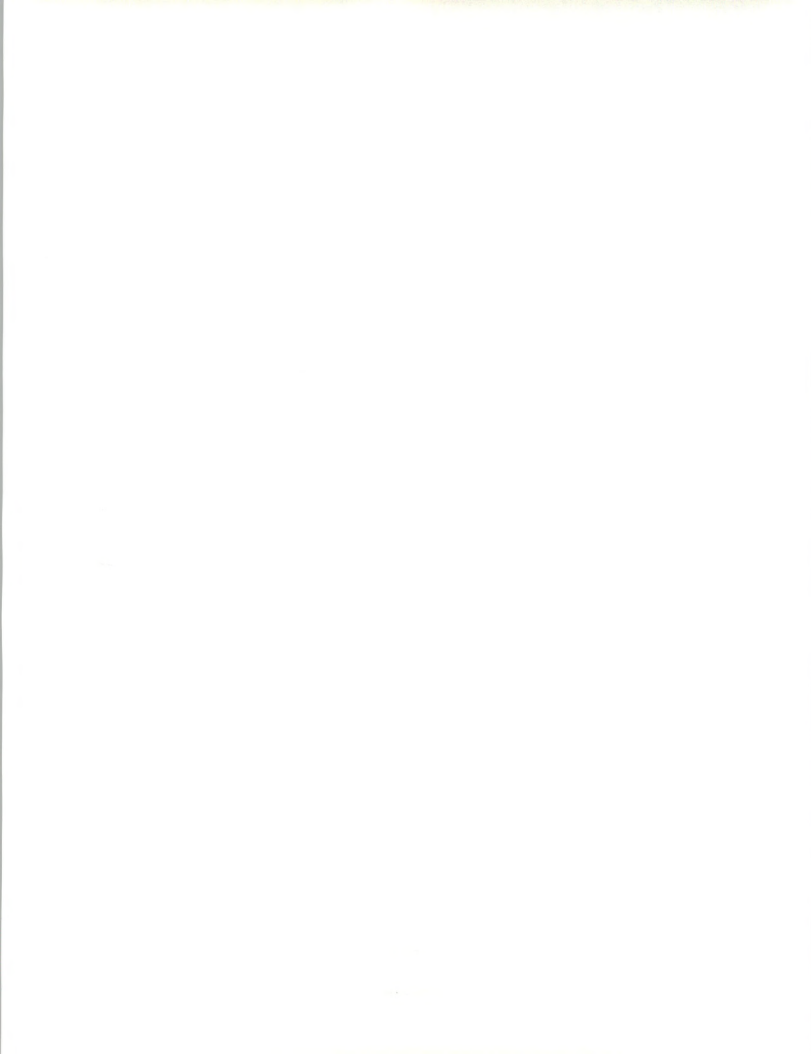
DVOIT Agency

- IT arm of Drivers and Vehicle Licensing Agency
- Five year contract with Department of Transport
- Transfer of 370 staff
- First Government Executive Agency to be privatised (Nov. '93)

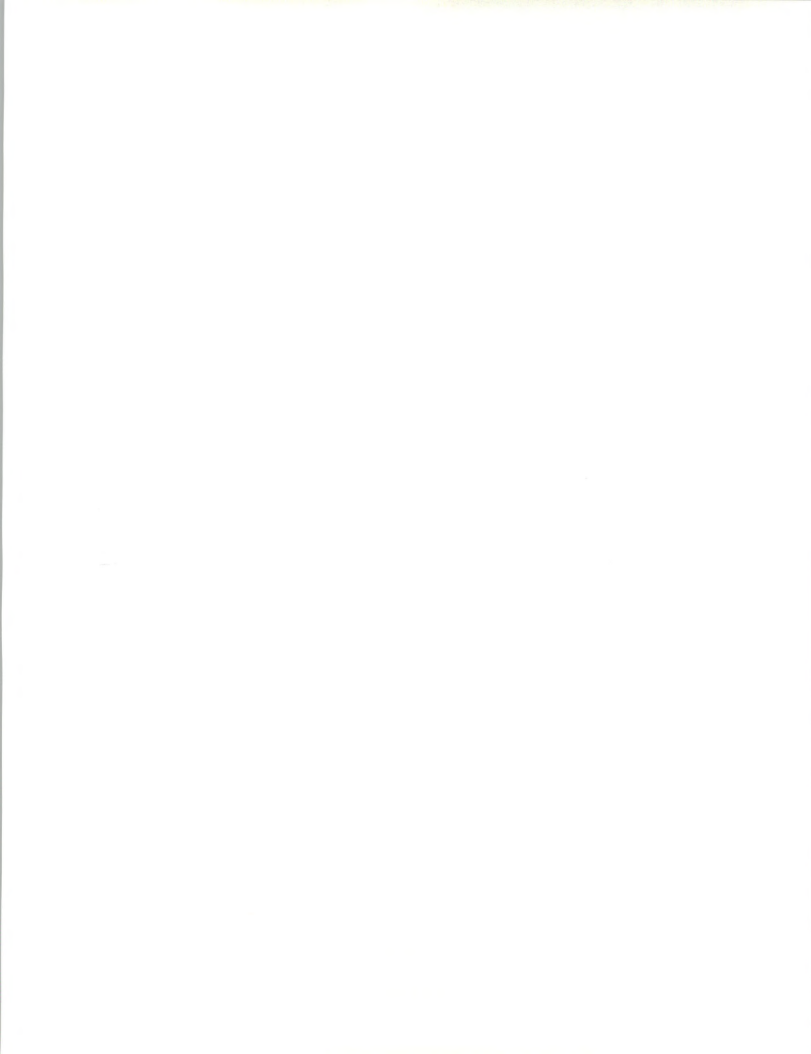
British Aerospace

- \$1.5b over ten years
- Aiming for cash injection and cost reduction
- Outsourcing consistent with corporate policy
- Award targeted for April 1994

IT Outsourcing in U.S. Federal Government

- Nothing major new in 1993/'94
- NASA and DOE have O&M contracts
 - Include IT operations
- CORN from DOT/FAA last major

- Contract “parts” rather than “whole”
- Procurement process barriers
 - Limited focus easier
 - Vendor availability limitations
